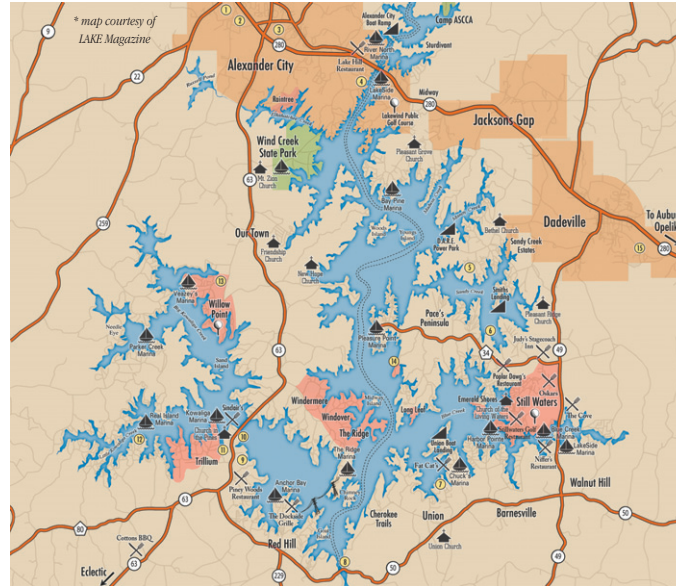

ABOUT LAKE MARTIN

Lake Martin, The Crown Jewel of the South, is located in Tallapoosa County, Elmore County, and Coosa County in Alabama. It is a 44,000 acre lake with over 750 miles of wooded shoreline. Lake Martin was formed after the completion of Martin Dam on the Tallapoosa River. Martin Dam is used to generate hydroelectric power for Alabama Power. The dam was begun in 1923 and completed in 1926. At the time of completion, the lake was the largest man-made lake in the world.

One of the largest artificial lakes in the United States, Lake Martin is a popular recreation destination for swimming, boating, fishing, water skiing, camping, and golfing. Many waterfront neighborhoods and luxury homes are located around Lake Martin. The cities of Alexander City and Dadeville are located nearby.

Lake Martin includes many popular attractions, including several small islands. Major lake landmarks include Wind Creek State Park, Kowaliga Bridge, Willow Point Country Club, Chimney/Acapulco Rock, Smith Mountain, the Martin Dam and the Lake Martin Amphitheater.
